Details: Peninsula Art Academy exhibit entitled *Storytelling: an Exhibition in Photojournalism*. Entries will be limited to student and amateur photographers only. Please submit current photos that capture the essence of the moment, including portraits, sports and daily life. Images may have basic adjustments only, no major alterations may have been made.

Prizes: Prizes will include; Best of Show, \$100, with first, second and third place in categories for student and amateur. When: Show runs April 24, thru June 30, 2010. An Artists Reception will be held on April 24, from 5-9pm. Please deliver your entries April 15 thru 18, 2010, between 11 am – 5 pm, with this completed form, or call to make other arrangements; we are very flexible. Pick up June 30, 2010, 11am – 5pm.

Registration: \$10 entry fee per artist for students, \$15 entry fee per artist for amateur photographers, this includes 2 entries, with one piece to hang, both if space permits.

Please include your Artist statement/bio with the entry form.

Size of the artwork is not limited, available space permitting; yet if needed, the artist must assist with installation. Photos must be current: printed, properly presented and ready to hang.

Subject matter considered unsuitable and/or unrelated to the exhibit theme will be returned.

PAA reserves the right to cancel exhibit if entries are insufficient; all fees would be returned.

"Entries will be handled with all possible care, but the Academy will not be responsible for loss or damage from any cause whatsoever. Submitting works of art to a show will imply an agreement on the part of the artist of the above conditions." You are responsible for insurance on your work.

Pricing: Please price your works if they are for sale - PAA keeps 40% commission on works sold. We request that entries be available for purchase, but may be NFS, if desired. No POR (price on request) will be honored. PAA is a tax-exempt 501 c (3) not-for-profit organization.

Shipping: If you are shipping your entries, please pack carefully, and ship to: Peninsula Art Academy, PO Box 171, Peninsula, Ohio, 44264, UPS/FedEx add street address: 1600 West Mill Street. Enclose a return shipping label, and a separate check payable to Peninsula Art Academy to cover return shipping including what level of insurance you require and moneys to cover. If sold, this check will be returned to you with your payment.

This exhibit will be posted on our website, and featured in our newsletter.
